NOTES FOR PROGRAMMERS

1. Public Folder

- a. Content for CFLbands.com is contained inside of the **public folder**.
- b. The public folder contains all pages related to the site.
- c. To change the look of the web site you must go into the styles.css file located in the public folder. Adding pages and content must me done within the respective files (i.e. index.php, bandfeature.php).

2. Images Folder

a. Images must be stored in the **images folder** located inside of the public folder. All images must have the correct path to work e.g. "images/logo.gif."

3. <u>Header.inc File</u>

- a. The **header.inc** file contains all of the content above and including the logo. If you wish to change the logo you must go into the header.inc file to change it. The logo image will have to be stored in the images file.
- b. Member pages have their own header.inc files for session based browsing.

4. Sidebars.inc File

- a. Sidebar content is located inside of the **sibebars.inc** file. Pictures and articles in this portion of the site are handled in this file. The content inside of the sidebars is handled entirely by this file, so updating the concert list bi-weekly is recommended.
- b. Member pages have their own sidebars.inc files for session-based browsing.

5. <u>Footer.inc File</u>

a. The **footer.inc** file contains everything at the bottom of the screen. Links can be added or changed at the programmer's discretion.

6. Modifying Files

a. Changing content must be handled by someone who is html-savvy and has experience as a content manager. Making sure content is placed in the appropriate spot is up to this person.

The only content that will be user-driven will be in the "view-shows.php" and "view-flyers.php" pages. These pages should be monitored for misuse and any errant postings will have to be deleted from their respective tables.

Pages that **SHOULD NOT** be modified include:

- Login.php
- Register.php
- Download_file.php
- Flyerupload.php
- Terms.php
- View-shows.php
- View-Flyers.php

EXPLANATION FOR SITE MANAGERS

Such as "This is how you register users" or "I did it this way for this reason."

- 1. To register users a user must provide their name, email and provide a band name. The bands table must be closely regulated so that unrelated material doesn't make its way onto the shows table.
- 2. Changing front page (index.php) content must be handled by someone who is html-savvy and has experience as a content manager. Making sure content is placed in the appropriate spot is up to this person. These operations are to be performed on the pages themselves (i.e. index.php, bandfeature.php)
- 3. The only content that will be user-driven will be in the "view-shows.php" and "view-flyers.php" pages. These pages should be monitored for misuse and any errant postings will have to be deleted from their respective tables.

KNOWN BUGS

- 1. The site works very fast, so some operation may seem like they have not been completed, but have. Just check the MySQL tables.
- 2. Users are able to access their member page by hitting the back button even after logging out.
- 3. The flyers can only be deleted via FTP to get the javascript to work, so the administrator will have to go into the "uploads" folder to delete them.
